Clinical examination of the above mentioned dog on *10/08/2010* (date) showed:

- No signs for the presence of patella luxation: (Patella "free").
- That on palpation of the left and/or right patella the capsule seems quite loose (to the inside and/or outside), but the patella is not luxatable.
- That the patella (left and/or right) is not stable enough located in the femoral trochlea: she can be luxated to the outside and/or the inside by rotating the tibia and/or by local pressure.
This animal has patella luxation grade 1.
- That the patella (left / right) at movement of the joint, when standing or walking, spontaneously (only occasionally / more often) luxates to the inside / outside.
This animal has patella luxation grade 2.
